
Nearly 50% of TIF Revenue generated in the City of Chicago in 2016 stems from 12 TIFs

• Of 145 TIFs in the City, these twelve (12) centrally located TIFs generated more than **\$277 million** of the **\$561 million total TIF revenue in 2016**. Nearly 50 percent of the total TIF revenue in the City was generated by less than 9 percent of the total number of Chicago TIFs.

- The first 11 of these TIFs generated more than \$100 million each in lifetime revenue.
- 6 "Phase Out"¹ TIFs: TIFs the City indicated it would phase out but have not yet terminated, generated a combined revenue of around \$148M this year.
- Jefferson/Roosevelt is centrally located within the area between North Avenue and Cermak, but has only generated \$61M since inception.

¹ In 2015 the Mayor indicated that these 7 downtown area TIFs would be terminated ahead of schedule. Thus far, one of the seven TIFs, Roosevelt/Canal, has been terminated.
