# Tuesday, March 15, 2016 – Presidential Primary Election General Information

Federal, State and Judicial candidates file with the Illinois State Board of Elections in Springfield. Candidates for Countywide offices, the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District, the Board of Review and Ward Committeemen for the City of Chicago file with the Cook County Clerk's office.

#### **Candidate Filing Dates & Deadlines**

Tuesday, September 1: First day to circulate petitions for established political parties

Monday, November 23 - Monday, November 30: Petition filing period for established political party candidates

**Monday, December 7:** Last day for filing objections to nomination papers of candidates who filed during the November 23 – November 30 filing period

Last day to withdraw for candidates who filed for incompatible offices

Wednesday, December 9: Last day to conduct lottery for ballot placement

Thursday, January 7: Last day to file withdrawal papers with the State Board of Elections

Wednesday, January 13: Last day to file withdrawal papers with the County Clerk

Thursday, January 14: Last day to file a notarized declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate (5:00 PM)

#### **Referenda Question Deadlines**

**Monday, December 14:** Last day for filing petitions for referenda for the submission of questions of public policy with the local election authority

**Monday, December 28:** Last day for local governing boards to adopt a resolution or ordinance to allow a binding public question to appear on the ballot

## **Certification of Ballot Deadlines**

Thursday, January 7: Certification of Ballot by the State Board of Elections

· Certification of Ballot by local election authorities

Wednesday, January 13: Certification of Ballot to the City of Chicago

### Voter Registration, Early Voting & Mail Voting

**Wednesday, December 16:** First day for to apply for a ballot by mail, ballots will not begin to be mailed until after February 4

Friday, January 29: Military & overseas ballots available

**Tuesday, February 16:** Online, mail and regular voter registration closes, after this date one must register and vote at a grace period site

Wednesday, February 17 - Monday, March 14: Grace period registration & voting

Monday, February 29 - Monday, March 14: Early Voting period

Thursday, March 10: Last day to apply for a ballot by mail

Friday, March 11 - Monday, March 14: Nursing home voting period
